IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

Position each dolly evenly & fully under opposite ends of the object to be lifted.

There are four nylon straps included to secure the cargo to the dolly. Wrap each nylon strap completely around the load & tighten securely through strap hooks. Always use all four nylon straps to secure cargo.

With each dolly fastened securely under opposite ends of the object to be lifted lower the lifting lever with one foot or both feet. Use the wooden handles for additional leverage if necessary, to press lifting lever down.

After each dolly has been raised successfully, use wooden handles to steer and/or push & pull dolly to desired location.

To lower load, use foot to raise lifting lever carefully on each dolly.

Remove nylon straps & remove each dolly from opposite ends of the cargo.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator. <u>IF</u> there is any doubt as to the operation or safety of the equipment, <u>DO NOT USE!!!
