

**WARNING  
BOLT CUTTERS**

Any piece of equipment can be dangerous if not operated properly. **YOU** are responsible for the safe operation of this equipment. The operator must carefully read and follow any warnings, safety signs and instructions provided with or located on the equipment. Do not remove, defeat, deface or render inoperable any of the safety devices or warnings on this equipment. If any safety devices or warnings have been removed, defeated, defaced or rendered inoperable, **DO NOT USE THIS EQUIPMENT!!!**

**NOT FOR USE ON REBAR!!**

**Always wear safety goggles when operating this equipment.**

Danger: This tool has and creates multiple pinch points. Keep hands, feet and other body parts clear at all times.

Danger: There is a chance of pieces of metal being shot off at high speeds. This could cause serious injury or death to the operator or bystanders. Keep bystanders, hands, feet and all other body parts clear of the cutting area at all times.

**IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW**

1. Cut with the piece all the way back in the cutter jaws. This will make the cutting action easier.
2. Keep cutter jaws at right angles to the piece being cut.
3. Make sure cutter bolts are tight before using.
4. Do not cut diagonally. This may twist the jaws out of line or chip the cutting edges.
5. Any damage to the cutter jaws is the customer's responsibility.  
**THE EQUIPMENT PROTECTION PLAN IS NOT OFFERED ON BOLT CUTTERS.**
6. Do not twist or pry with the tool while cutting.
7. Do not take a full cut on a metal when the hardness is unknown.
8. Do not exceed cutter capacity marked on the jaws of the tool.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator. **IF** there is any doubt as to the operation or safety of the equipment,
